
DANIEL TIMELINE 605 B.C. - 70 A.D.



Detailed Key:

Babylon – Represented by the Head of gold in Nebuchadnezzar's statue dream (Ch. 2), Lion with wings in Daniel's vision in Chapter 7.

539 B.C. – Handwriting on the Wall (Daniel 5). Belshazzar is killed and the Medo-Perian rule begins.

Medo-Persia – Represented by the chest of silver in the statue dream, Bear with ribs in mouth in Chapter 7, and Ram with one longer horn in Chapter 8. Persia rose to dominance in the alliance and was ruled by Cyrus. Cyrus is the son of Xerxes mentioned in Esther. Cyrus allowed Jews to rebuild temple.

Greece – Represented by the torso of bronze in statue dream, 4-headed Leopard in Chapter 7, and Goat with horn in Chapter 8.

Antiochus – After the big horn breaks off the goat (Ch. 8), four horns rise up (Generals of Alexander the Great), then a little horn. Antiochus is the little horn in chapter 8.

Rome – Represented by the legs of iron in the statue dream and the undescribed fearful beast in Chapter 7.

Little Horn (Chapter 7 with eyes and a mouth) – Represents the Antichrist yet to come also described in Revelation 13.
